

Idaho County Recycling

We will gladly accept CLEAN SORTED articles from these five categories:



Cardboard (all types)

Brown paper sacks, cereal and food boxes, beverage cases, cardboard tubes, etc... Box tape and staples are okay. Boxes must be flattened, NO wax-lined boxes, foil or Styrofoam.





All white office paper, junk mail, labels from cans, other kinds of paper. -NO gift wrap, wax paper, paper towels, tissue or other trash.





Tin & Aluminum Cans

CEREA

Labels must be removed. NO loose tin lids, aluminum foil, aerosol or pressurized containers, paint, hydrocarbon, fuel, pesticide or herbicide containers.



Other Paper

Newspaper, magazines, catalogues, paperback books, and phone books **only.**



Plastic Bottles

Containers must have an opening smaller than the bottom of the container. Lids must be discarded. Labels may remain attached. -NO plastic bags, plastic clamshells, Styrofoam, or other kinds of plastic trash. (Shrink wrap acceptable)
