Purpose and Methodology

- ❑ The Idaho County Recycling Task Force sought residents' input about recycling.
- ❑ A survey was developed for distribution, and for budget reason, a web-based format was chosen.
- ❑ The survey was available online from June 1 to June 15, 2009.
- ❑ A link to the survey was provided from the Idaho County web site, promoted in local media, and emailed to County residents and businesses.
- ❑ 818 surveys were completed.

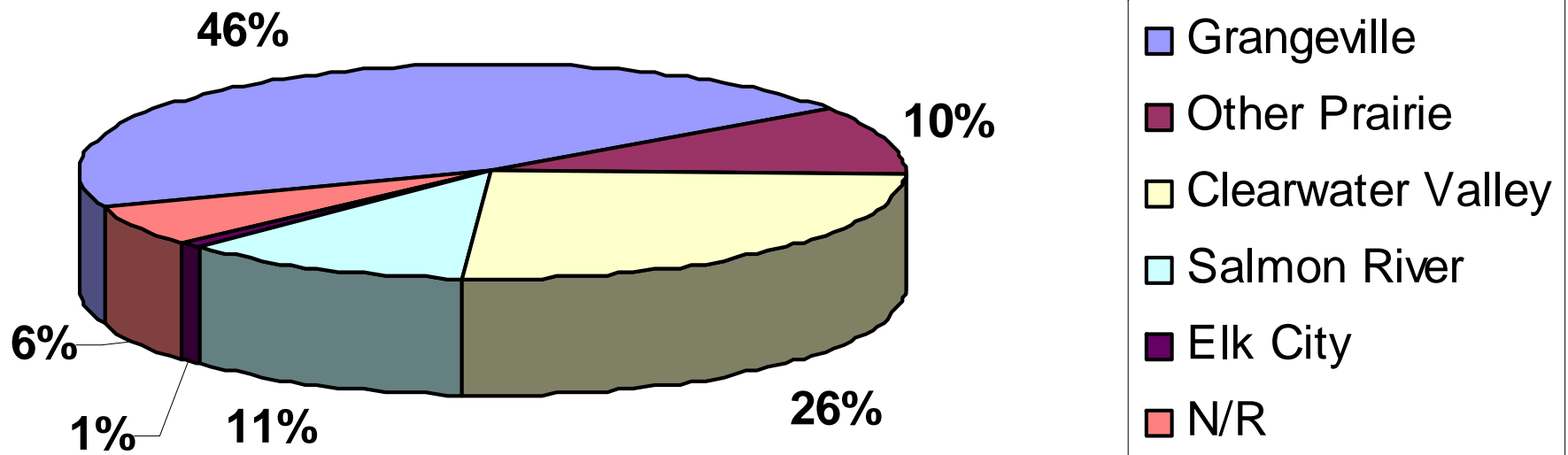

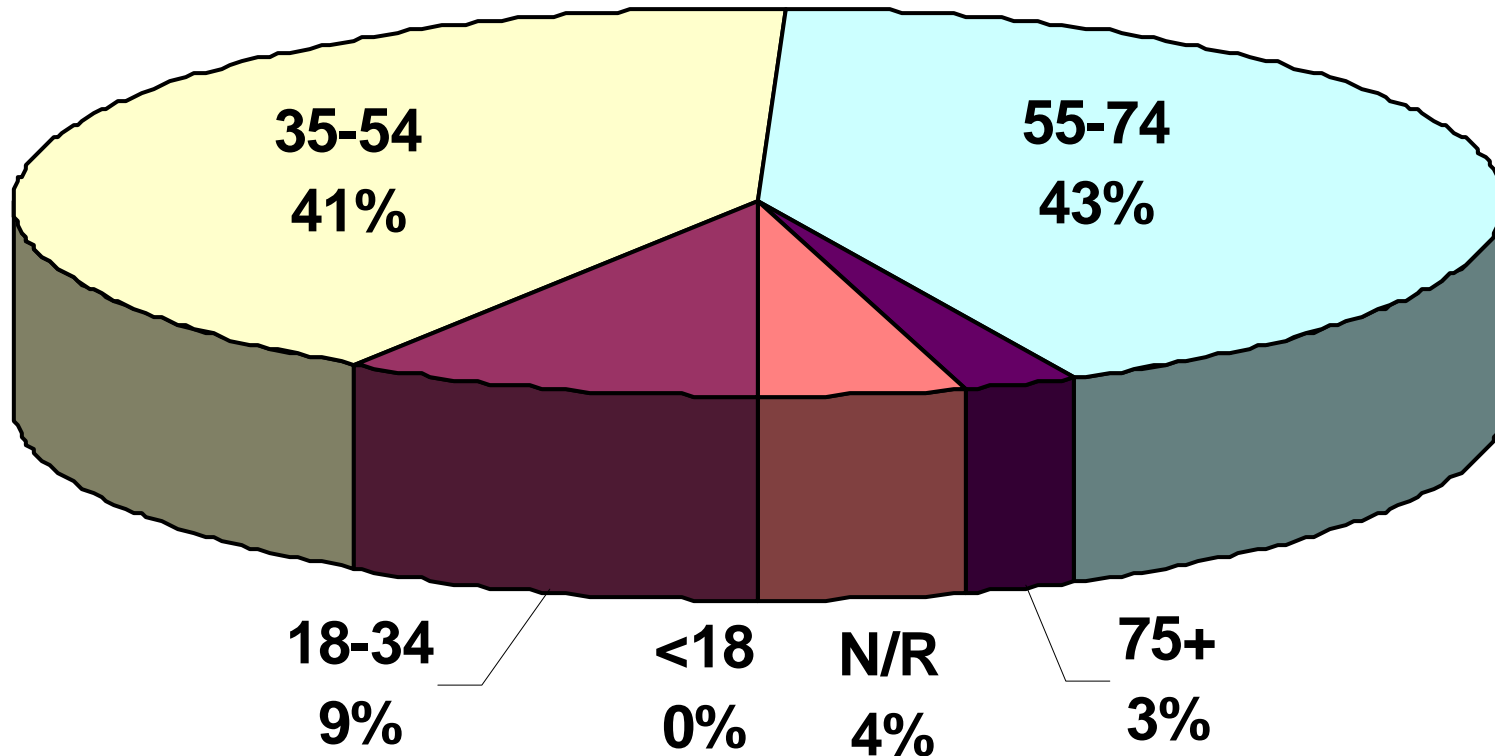

5. What additional comments do you have about a recycling program in Idaho County?

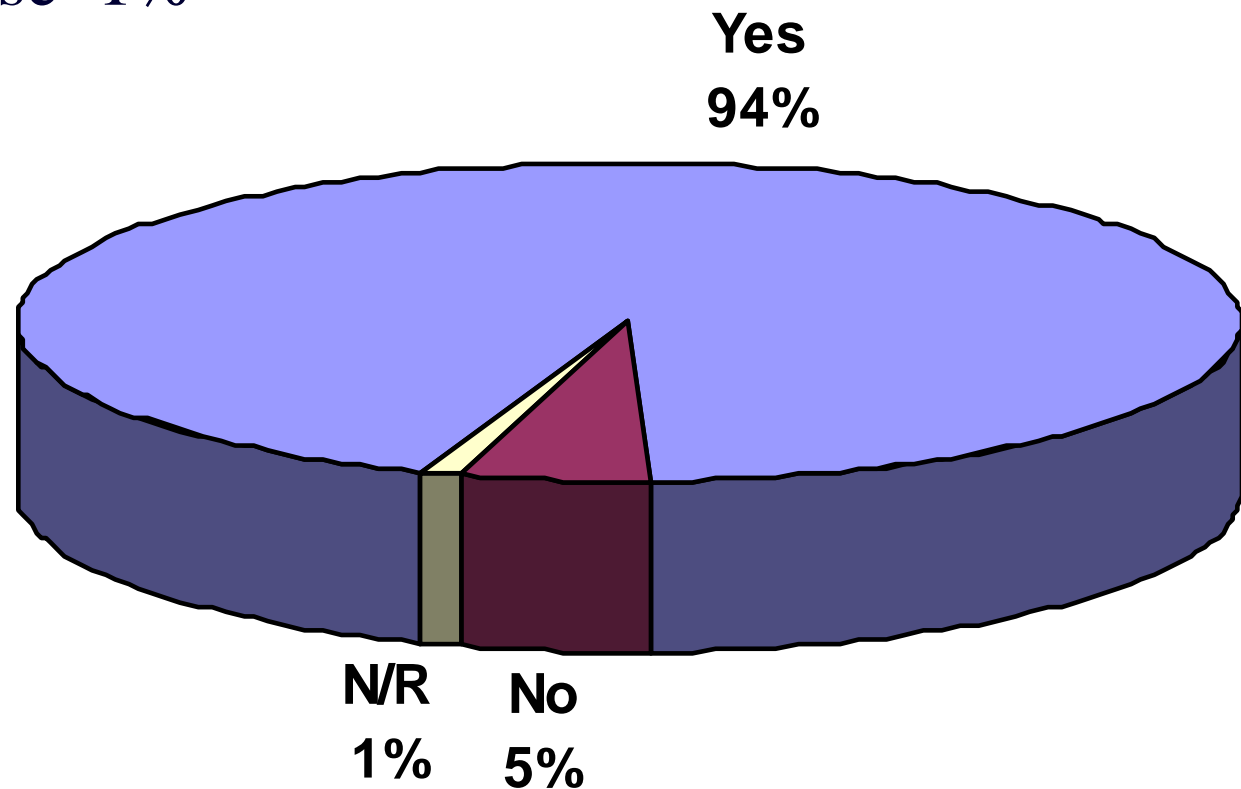

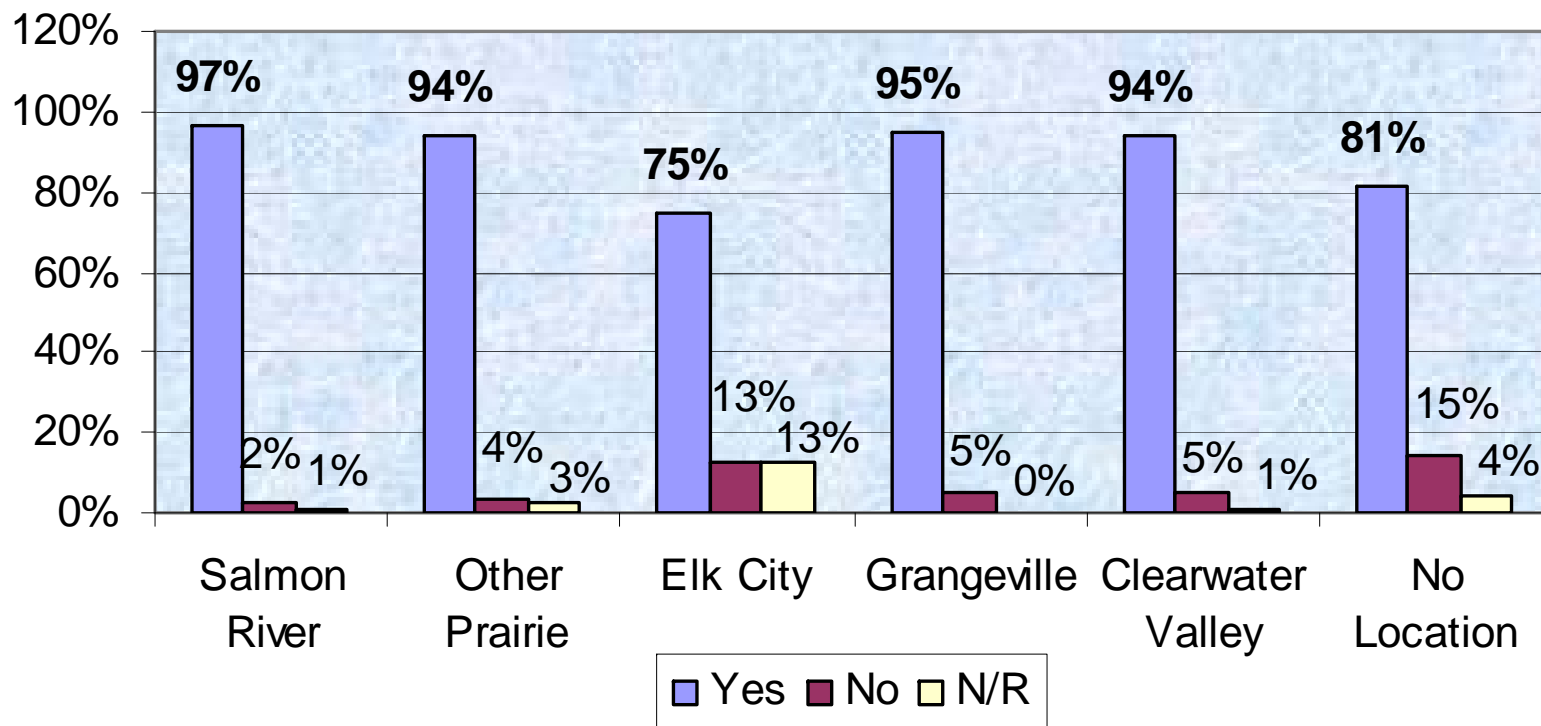
Q1. Would you recycle?

- Overall, 94% would recycle, 5% would not
- No response 1%



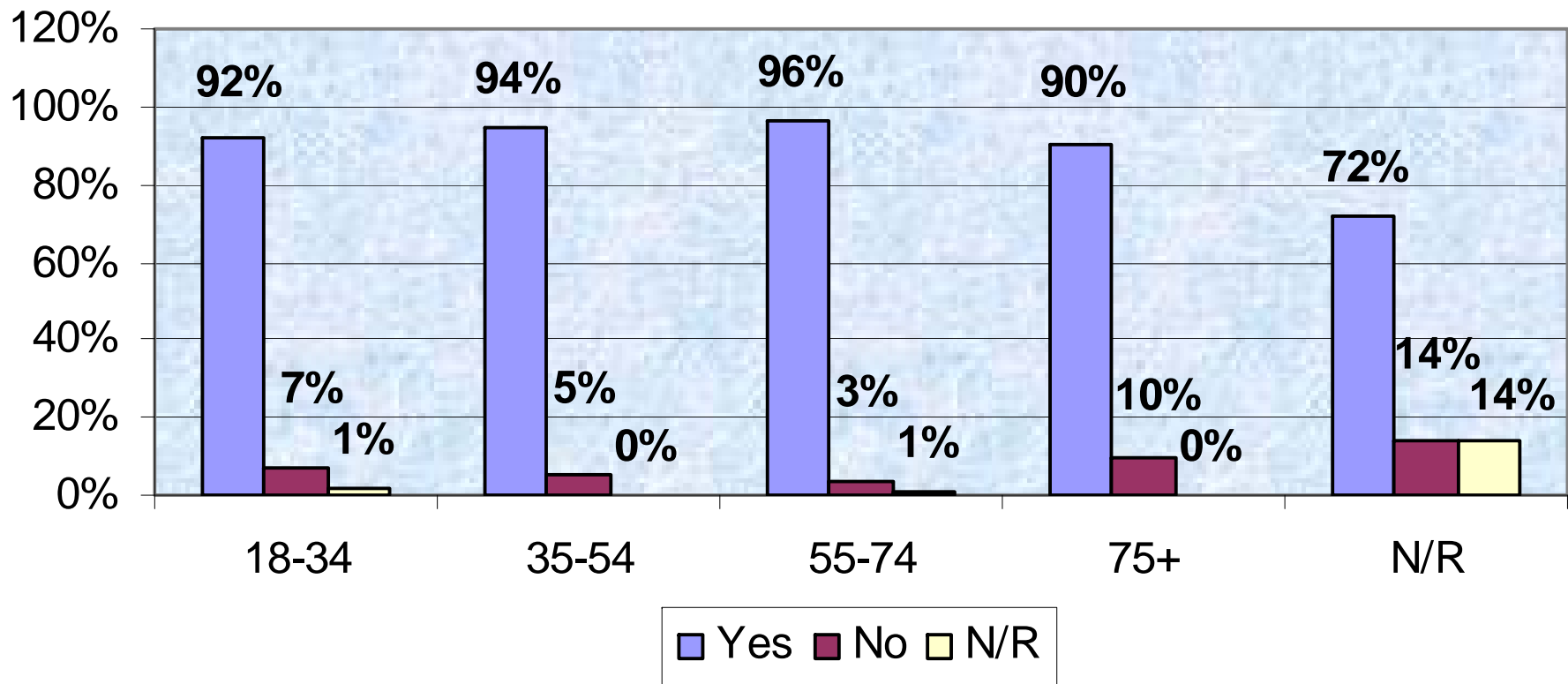
Willingness to Recycle by Location

- All communities except Elk City 94%+,
- Three-quarters of Elk City respondents would recycle
- Salmon River highest percent of Yes responses.

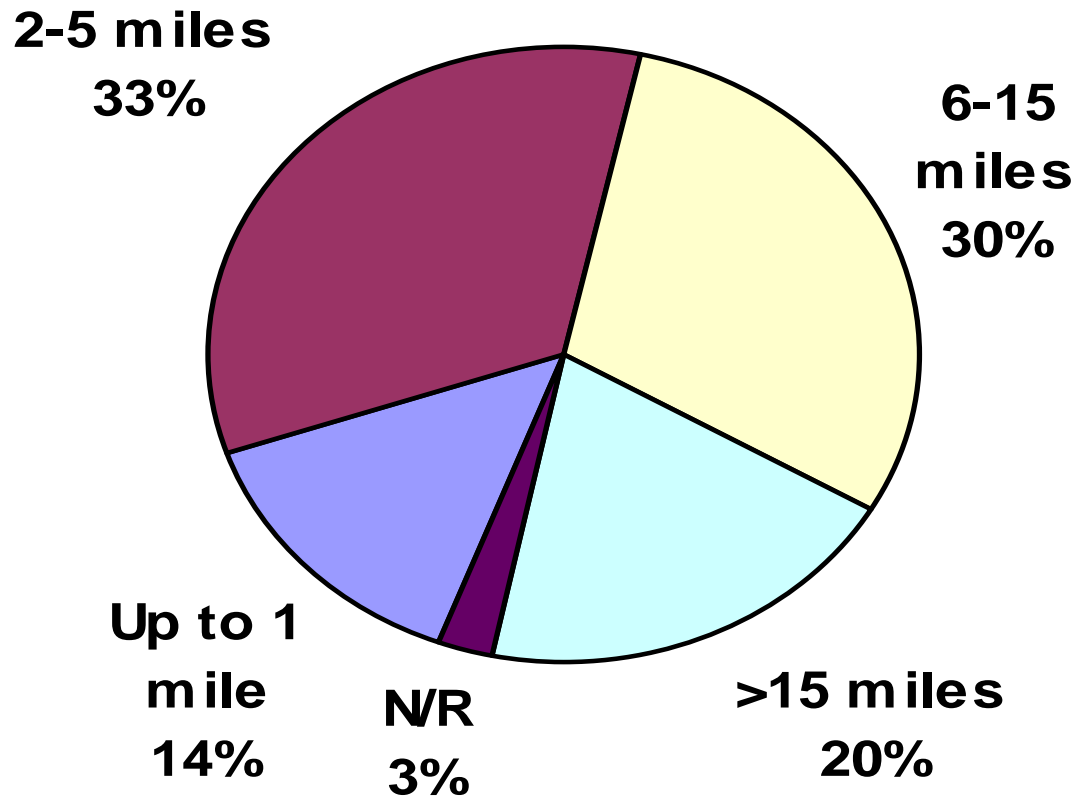


Willingness to Recycle by Age

- 90%+ of all age groups would recycle.



Q2. How far would you travel to a recycling drop-off point?



- One-third would travel 2-5 miles
- Nearly 1/3 would travel 6-15 miles
- 1-in-5 would travel 15 miles or more

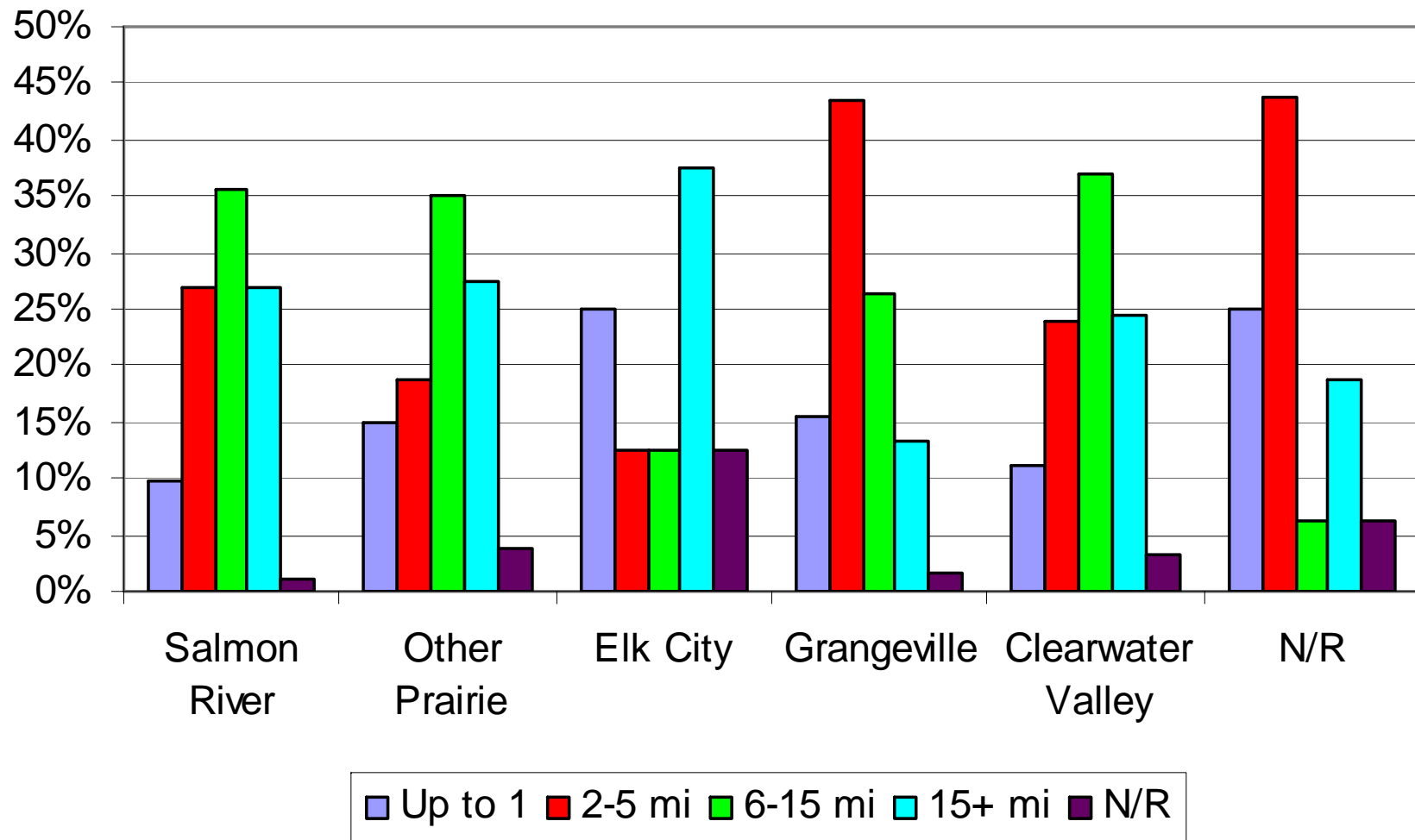
Distance willing to travel (cont'd)

- Highest % willing to travel distance are in Elk City.
- Other Prairie (Cottonwood-Ferdinand-Greencreek) also high % willing to travel.
- Grangeville least willing to travel longer distances.

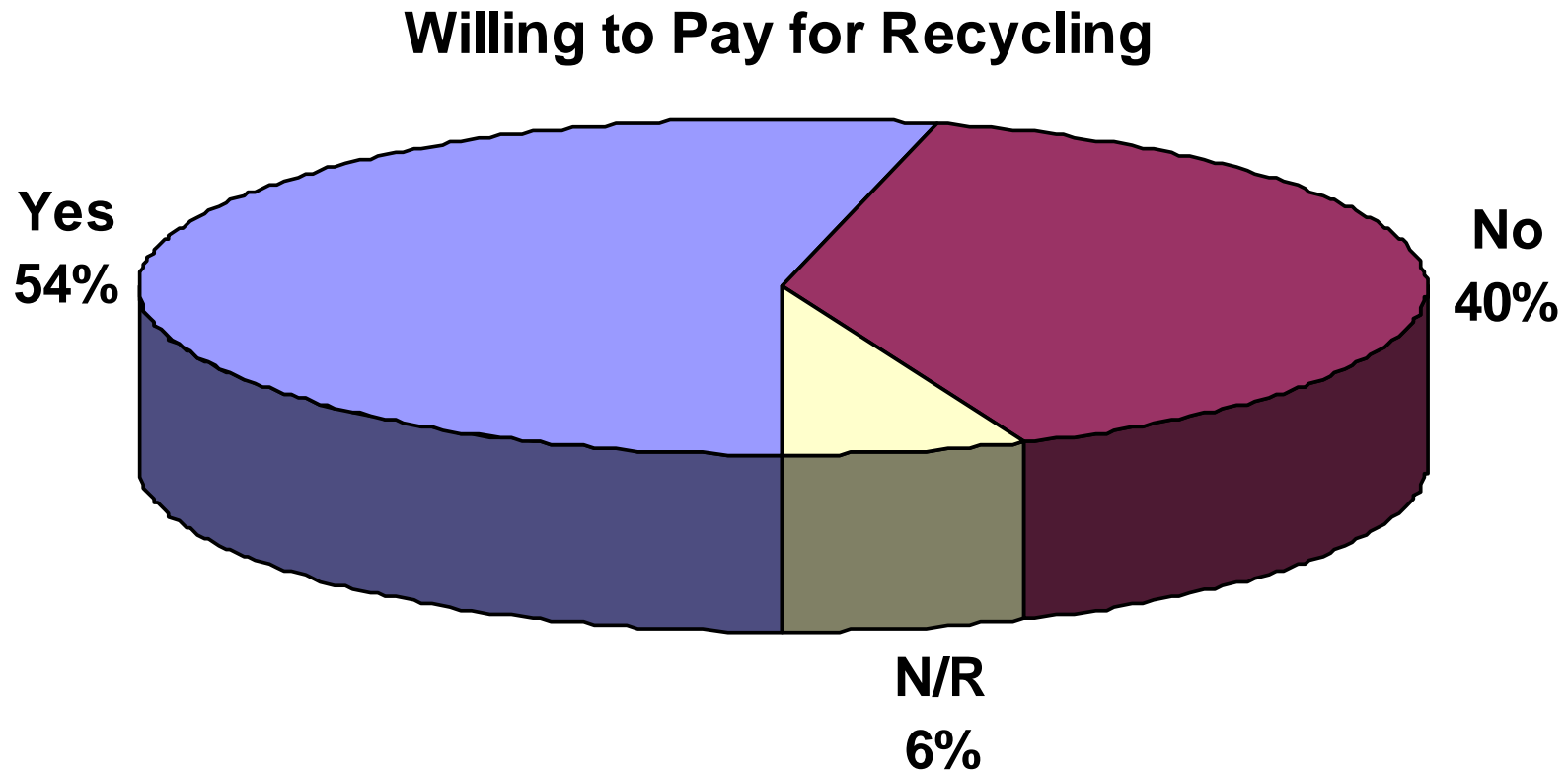


Q3. What items would you recycle?

- More than half of respondents would recycle all items except yard and construction waste.

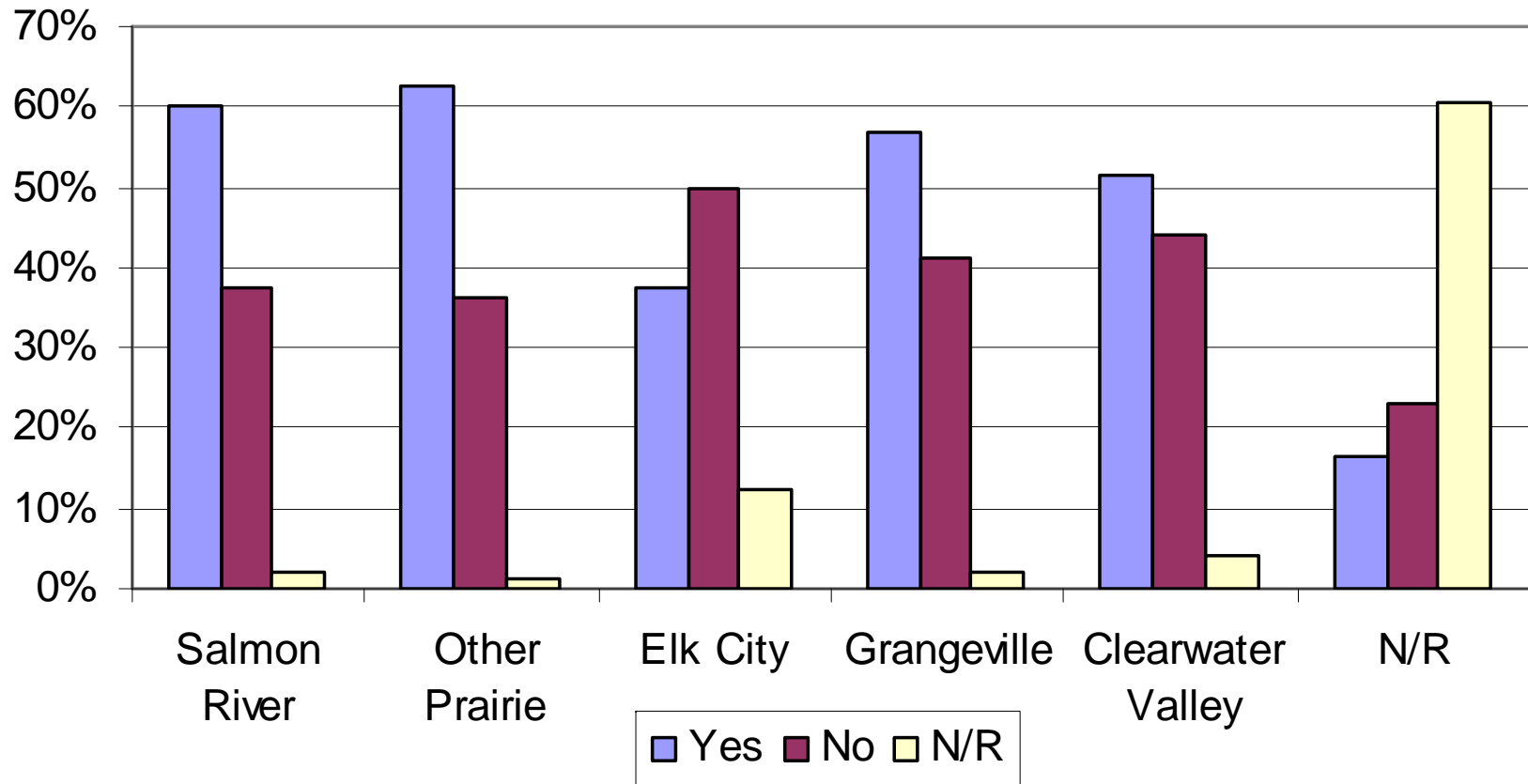

Q4. Willing to pay to support a recycling effort in your community?



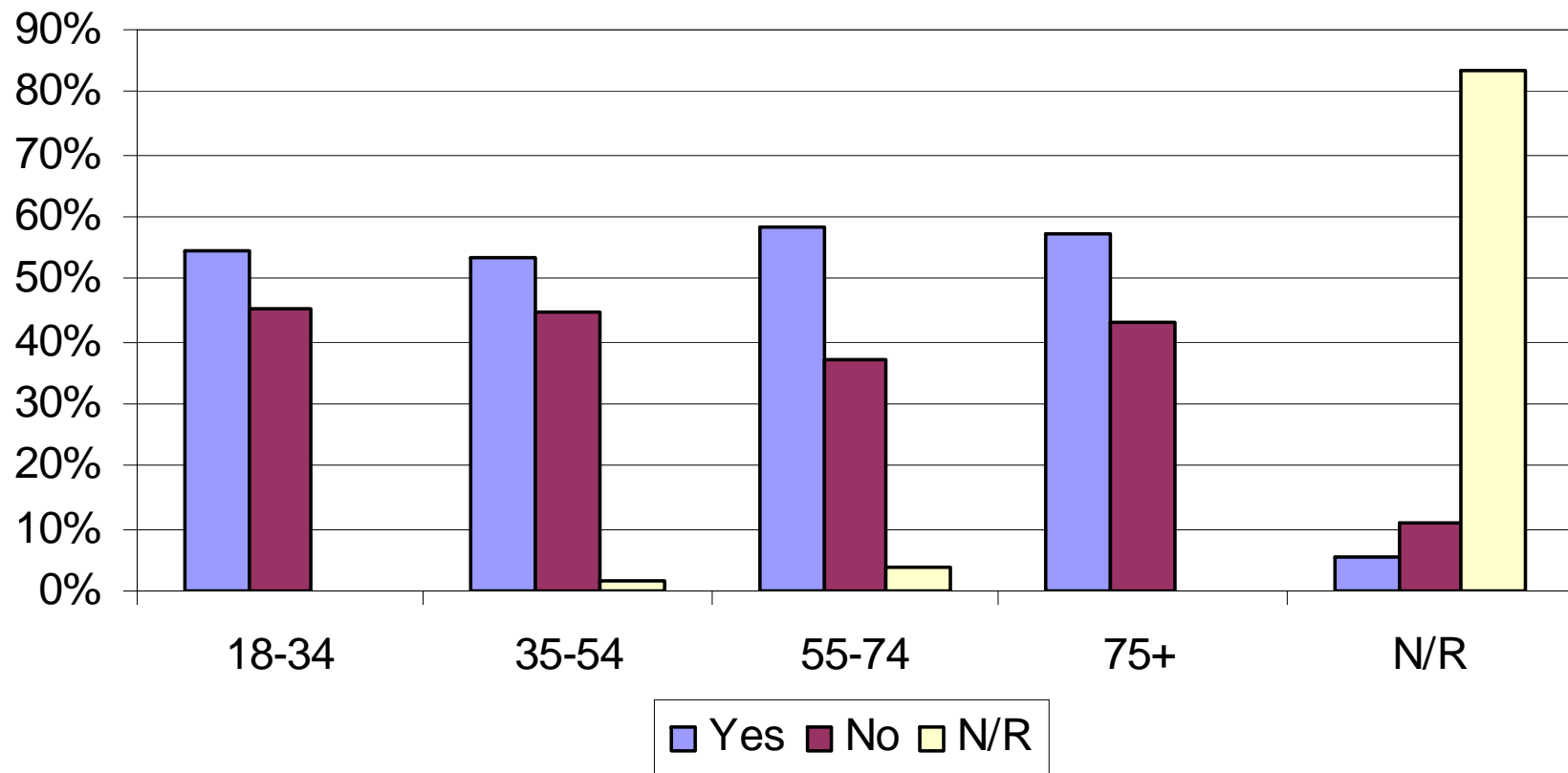
Willing to pay by location

- Majority willing to pay in all areas except Elk City.



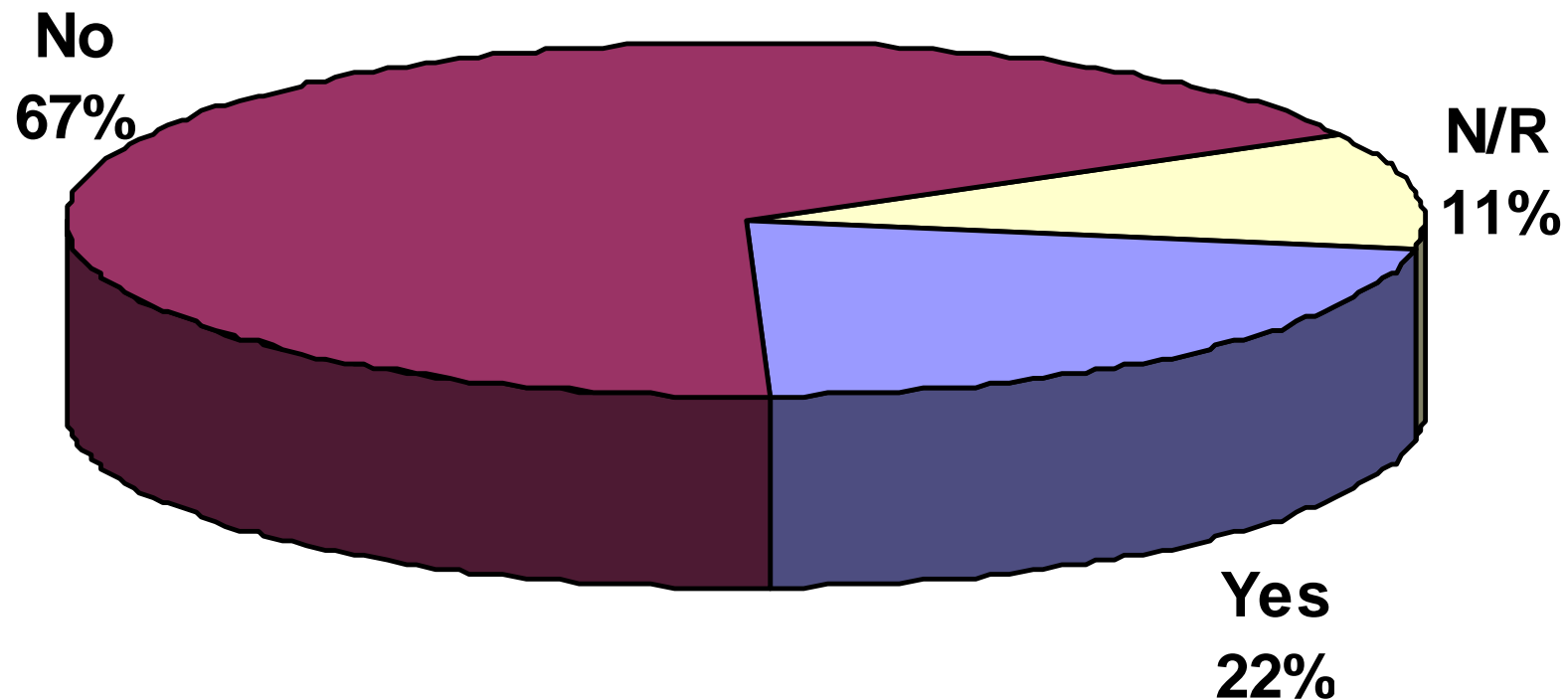
Willing to pay by age group...

- Majority of all age groups willing to pay, but margins slimmest in 18-34 and 35-54 age groups.



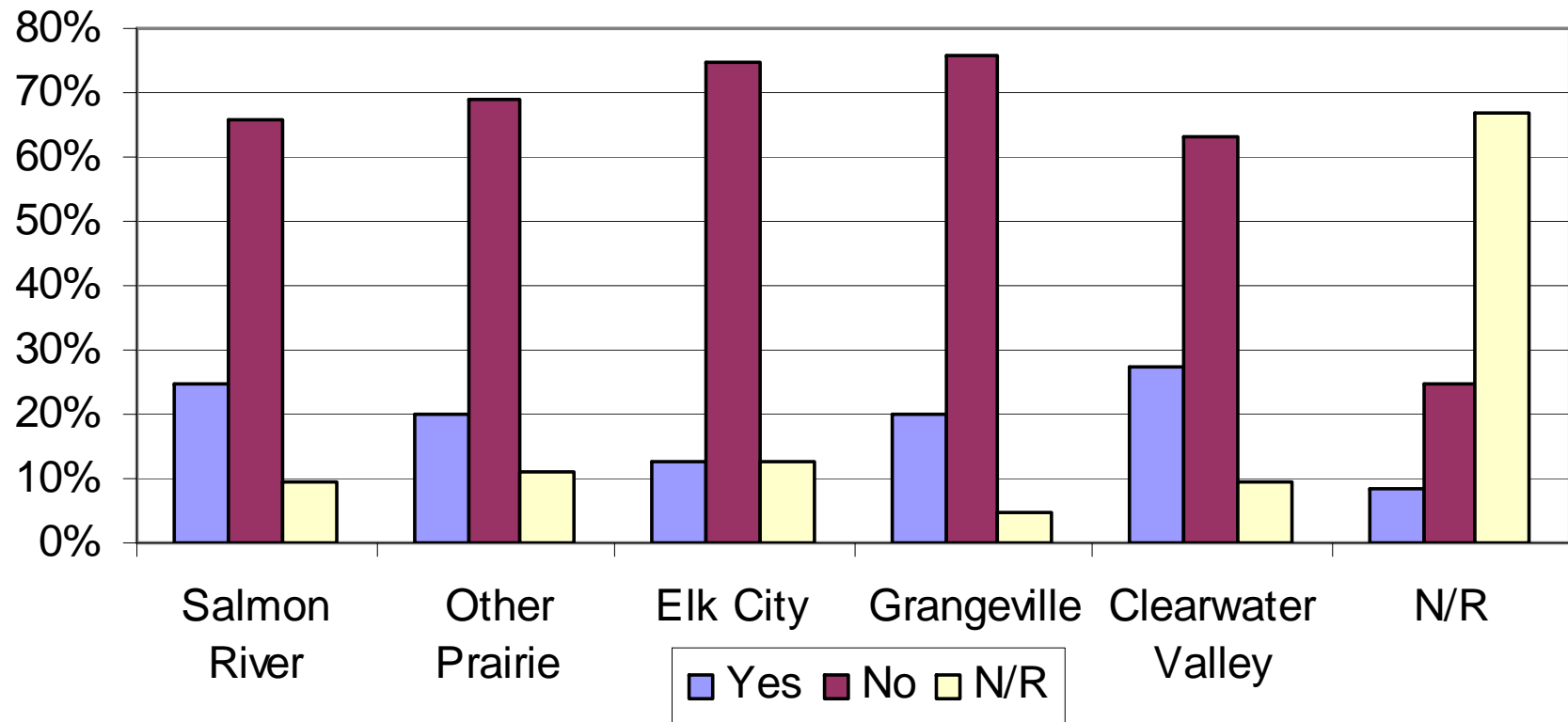
Q8. Willing to volunteer?
