The following items are NOT ACCEPTED as part of our E-waste program:

- Appliances: stoves, refrigerators, freezers, light fixtures, portable heaters, baseboard heaters, furnaces, air conditioners, sewing machines, vacuum cleaners, and plumbing fixtures. Refer recycling of these to Sutton Salvage at 29061 Old Spiral Highway in Lewiston (phone 1-800-209-6119). Depending on the item, they may pay you for it. Call first for information.
- Lightbulbs. Refer recycling or proper disposal of these to Transfer Station or Asotin County Landfill at 2901 6th Avenue, Clarkston, WA (phone 509-758-9230)
- No neon lights of any kind.
- Liquid Acid type batteries - automobile/RV/boat/motorcycle/mowers/etc. Refer recycling of these to Auto Paint and Parts at 1005 Main Street in Lewiston (phone 208-746-8640).
- Liquid fuel powered tools - mowers, tillers, trimmers, mixers, sprayers, pumps or saws. Refer recycling of these to Sutton Salvage on the Old Spiral Highway.
- Television Sets - regardless of size, shape, screen type or working condition. Refer recycling or proper disposal of these to Transfer Station or Asotin County Landfill.
