TO LEVY A SPECIAL TAX LEVY

Shall the Board of Commissioners of the Kamiah Fire Protection District be authorized and empowered to increase its budget pursuant to Idaho Code Section 31-1423 (l) by a special tax levy to pay for the fire protection apparatus, equipment, facilities maintenance and provide for firefighter safety and training, in the amount of Ninety Five Thousand and No/100s Dollars [\$95,000.00] commencing with the fiscal year 2017-2018 and then establish said amount as the base amount for all subsequent fiscal years as authorized by law, for the purpose of providing fire protection and life preservation services as provided in the resolution of the Board of Commissioners of the Kamiah Fire Protection District adopted on August 8, 2016.

IN FAVOR OF authorizing the levy, not to exceed the sum
