

IDAHO COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 63

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE AMENDMENT OF IDAHO COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 50; SPECIFICALLY PROVIDING FOR THE AMENDMENT OF SECTION 4; PROVIDING FOR THE ORDINANCE BECOMING EFFECTIVE UPON ITS PASSAGE, APPROVAL, AND PUBLICATION; PROVIDING FOR THE AMENDMENT OF ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; SECTION 4 SHALL BE AMENDED AS FOLLOWS:

The last line of Section 4 shall be amended to remove the words "or other general use" at the end of Section 4. Section 4 shall read as follows, to wit:

"Section 4: The definition of the word installed as contained here in this ordinance shall be defined as follows: installed shall be defined as the placing, by any means, a unit anywhere within the unincorporated limits of Idaho County, including the placing of a unit on the ground, on blocks, on cement, foundation, on the trailer, or other foundation for residential occupancy. However, the unit, if not being used for residential occupancy, shall not be placed within 300 feet of any other residence or any other landowner's building, garage, shop, barn, shed, office or other structure."

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF IDAHO COUNTY, IDAHO, Idaho County Ordinance No. 50 passed and adopted on the 11th day of July, 2005, shall be amended to read as follows:

"Section 4: The definition of the word installed as contained here in this ordinance shall be defined as follows: installed shall be defined as the placing, by any means, a unit anywhere within the unincorporated limits of Idaho County, including the placing of a unit on the ground, on blocks, on cement, foundation, on the trailer, or other foundation for residential occupancy. However, the unit, if not being used for residential occupancy, shall not be placed within 300 feet of any other residence or any other landowner's building, garage, shop, barn, shed, office or other structure."

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

This ordinance shall become effective upon its passage, approval, and publication in the Idaho County Free Press.
