February 28, 2005

THIRD TERM DAY

The Board met at 9:00 a.m. with Randy Doman, Jim Rehder, Alice Mattson, Commissioners and Rose Gehring, Clerk, present.

Jon Stroop re: road report. Capital investments discussed – requested order of new pickup – $\frac{3}{4}$ or 1 ton. Jim requested an inventory of road department equipment.

Prairie Elementary School Eighth Graders visited commissioners – later toured the courthouse.

Esther and Don Morrow re: Elk City Wagon Road – presented commissioner history of road along with documentation. Discussion followed.

Jim wants research on this road – was road abandoned – doesn't want financial responsibility.

Randy checked with SHIPO – nomination to registry will not affect county maintenance of road.

Alice wants to let landowners know this road may be placed on national registry.

Commissioners will write letter in favor of this road to be nominated to the National Registry after further information is obtained.

Alice wants to know which is forest service boundary and county boundary – also will a hearing be necessary – will check with legal council.

Estile Hunt re: road in Twiligar Subdivision – when he purchased property – deed did not state there was a public road through his two lots.

Randy explained subdivision roads are dedicated to public.

Final Twiligar plat does not have a road going through tract 1C and 1B. Estile does not want a public road through his property.

Kirk MacGregor entered – Randy explained discrepancy on plats – is road private or public – prescriptive use discussed – Kirk will review and get back with commissioners.

Claim from Transcar America - \$4,347.65 – for transfer of prisoners. Discussion followed – since ordered by Judge Bradbury – claim will be taken out of District Court Budget.

Skott Mealer increase in wage discussed – promotion was given to Mealer over a year ago – no increase in wage. Jim made motion to approve wage increase. Randy seconded. Discussion. Motion carried with Randy and Jim in favor. Alice abstained – effective March 14, 2005.

Alice Mattson re: Warren trip – problems with snow grooming trails – meeting will be held March 9th – wants someone to meet with Valley County commissioners and residence of area – discussion followed – Alice will attend if she is able to – county will pay for room and board.

Cooperating status of Payette agreement – on their travel plan – Holmberg did not attend meetings – appointed someone to represent her/ Idaho County – Randy explained process of agreements of this type – he is reluctant to have someone from another county represent Idaho County – discussion followed.

Randy made motion to rescind cooperating agreement between Payette National Forest and Idaho County. Jim seconded. Motion carried with Randy and Jim in favor. Alice abstained. Randy will draft letter notifying Payette National Forest that no one will be representing Idaho County on their board.

Bob McCall, Chris Remacle, and Nancy Edwards re: Nutrition program – gave over view – meals are put on by the LCSC Nutrition Center for the senior citizens – volunteer labor – cannot charge for meals – donation of \$3.00/meal – requesting funding from county – decision tabled until further information is received.

Commissioners reviewed correspondence.
