New Business Only (Will review 4/19 minutes and old business at regular meeting in July 2019.)

A referral for possible guardianship of a vulnerable adult was received by Ellen Aiken of Grangeville Health and Rehabilitation. L.B. was recently admitted to Syringa Hospital last week and then sent to Grangeville Health and Rehabilitation. We received a letter from the physician attending to this person, that states that they are unable to make decisions in their own best interest and not able to manage their finances. It has also been alleged that the potential ward's daughter has been taking the potential ward's money under the threat of physical and psychological harm. The only other living relative is stated to be unable to care for this person either this relative has many health ailments they see the L.B. is currently in Grangeville Health and Rehabilitation as it was determined by the hospital that they could not care for themselves physically at this time. It was also alleged that the daughter may try to claim the potential ward at any time.

Kirk reviewed the material and thinks this could qualify for emergency guardianship with the judge. Andrea S. motioned for the board to submit for emergency guardianship at this time. Tara N. seconded. The vote was unanimous. The board will be designated as temporary guardians if the judge agrees. Joan and Jerry Haaland volunteered to be point of contact. Kirk will begin work on the family contacts.

Our next meeting will be on July 18, 2019. Alan F. moved to adjourn the meeting and Larry C. seconded it. The meeting was adjourned by unanimous vote.
