

## REQUEST FOR STATEMENTS OF QUALIFICATIONS AND PROPOSALS

Idaho County is requesting proposals from private for-profit internet service providers to provide all services, equipment, and construction to deploy, own and operate a fixed wireless broadband system to serve approximately 350 households in the Elk City area.

The county is applying to the state of Idaho Broadband Grant Program to fund the project.

Proposals will be evaluated and ranked on the following criteria. The maximum point value of each criterion is shown in the parentheses:

Capability to Perform Project	(20 pts)
Relevant Project Experience	(15pts)
Qualifications of Project Team	(20 pts)
Benefits of the Project to the Community Served	(25pts)
Project Approach and Schedule	(20 pts)
