

Idaho County, Idaho Voting Instructions

How to Vote Your Ballot

1. Use a **black or blue ink pen or a number 2 pencil** to mark your ballot.
2. Fill in the oval **completely** 
3. Do not vote for more than the number of candidates specified in each race on the ballot.
4. If you make a mistake, contact the Idaho County Elections Dept. at (208) 983-2751 or email kackerman@idahocounty.org as soon as possible to request a new ballot.

How to Return Your Ballot

1. After voting, fold the ballot page.
2. Place the **voted ballot** in the “**Voted Ballot**” envelope provided and seal the envelope.
3. Place the “**Voted Ballot**” envelope in the pre-addressed return envelope and **sign** the affidavit on the back of the return envelope. **Affix return postage of \$.70.**
4. **Failure to sign your name will cause your ballot to NOT be counted.**

Ballots **must** be received in our office by 8:00 p.m. on November 3, 2020 in order to be counted. Mail or hand deliver to the Idaho County Auditor Recorder’s office at 320 W. Main St Grangeville, Id 83530.

Ballots received after November 3, 2020 will not be counted regardless of postmark date.

Would you rather go to the polls? PLEASE READ THIS! You are receiving an absentee ballot because you previously requested a ballot be mailed for this election. **THIS BALLOT MUST BE RECEIVED BACK, UNVOTED, IN ORDER TO ISSUE A NEW BALLOT.** Take this ballot with you to your regular polling location on Election Day. It will be ‘spoiled’ and a new ballot issued. **OR**, return this unvoted ballot back to the Idaho County Courthouse no later than October 30, so the precinct poll book will reflect your eligibility to receive a new ballot.

VOTED ABSENTEE BALLOTS ARE ONLY ACCEPTED AT THE IDAHO COUNTY COURTHOUSE. Please help us ensure that your vote is counted!
