

NOTICE OF REQUEST FOR STATEMENT OF QUALIFICATIONS

IDAHO COUNTY ROAD AND BRIDGE – BIG CEDAR 1 SLIDE REPAIR DESIGN/BUILD PROJECT

Pursuant to Idaho Code 67-2805, "Procurement of Public Works Construction", Idaho County, Idaho is requesting Statements of Qualifications (SOQ) from licensed public works contractors who are interested in bidding on the **Big Cedar 1 Slide Repair Design/Build Project**. The Project generally consists of stabilizing approximately 450 lineal feet of landslide, repairing approximately 500 lineal feet of roadway, subsurface and surface drainage improvements, and associated surface restoration.

The opinion of estimated project cost for each phase is between \$2,500,000 and \$5,000,000. It is expected that the project will bid during January of 2021 with a contract completion of September 30, 2021. Idaho County reserves the right to cancel or postpone bidding or award of a contract for the project or to bid the project in several packages.

The Request for SOQ Informational Packet contains the project description, SOQ Form and requirements, and evaluation criteria. Contractors must submit a response in the format outlined in the Request for Contractor Qualifications to be considered for bidding on the Project. Any response may be withdrawn prior to the scheduled time below for the opening of the responses or authorized postponement thereof. Copies of the SOQ Informational Packet may be obtained from:

When emailing an SOQ, the proposer must call Idaho County to verify receipt of the SOQ by Idaho County prior to the deadline time and date. All responses must be signed and proposing firms must have a currently valid Idaho Public Works Contractor license, appropriate class for this project, in order to submit.

Upon receipt of SOQs, Idaho County will evaluate and determine which contractors are qualified to bid. If Idaho County proceeds with bidding of the project, all firms deemed qualified by Idaho County will be invited to submit formal bids for the project as delineated in the Project Manual. Formal bid forms will generally conform to the format specified in the most recent Idaho Standards for Public Works Construction (ISPWC) and Engineers Joint Contract Documents Committee (EJCDC) Contract Documents.

Any protest of determination of qualifications or bidding procedures will be handled in accordance with procedures detailed in IC 67-2805.

Firms will be responsible for all costs (including site visits, if any) incurred in preparing or responding to this request for SOQ's.
