Idaho County Board of Community Guardians Emergency Meeting 3.30.23

The Board of Guardians met to discuss initiating temporary guardianship for LB as requested per referral from Alison Salyer, LMSW, St Lukes Hospital, McCall. LB is a 73 year- old female resident of Riggins Idaho. Her current diagnosis is acute cerebral vascular accident with complete left ICA occlusion. Past medical history includes stroke, coronary artery disease, hypothyroidism, mixed hyperlipidemia, unstable angina, hypertension, uncontrolled type 2 diabetes, STEMI, thickened endometrium with suspicion for endometrial dysplasia, and adjustment disorder with mixed anxiety and depressed mood.

At this time the patient is deemed medically unsafe to return home to care for herself and she does not have anyone to care for her at home. Her son just recently passed away. The medical team recommends LB be transferred to a skilled nursing facility for long-term care. She cannot be transferred until guardianship is secured.

Debbie Hays moved the Board of Guardians initiate temporary guardianship for LB. Nolene Weaver seconded it. The motion passed. Chris Hagenbuch will notify Matt Jessup, assistant county prosecutor, to initiate emergency guardianship

Debbie Hays volunteered to serve as guardian for the short term, if need be, until a permanent guardian is established.

Old Business:

- Guardianship for TL has been filled by a family member. Chris will follow up with Kirk to see if we need to do anything else.
- Alan and Lynda Fox provided an update on their ward, LM. The care facility is asking them to spend down some
 of LM's personal finances. The care facility recommended a wheel chair be purchased. Alan and Lynda will
 comply with this request and purchase a wheel chair for LM.
- Chris will follow up with Kirk on the emergency guardianship of MR that was to occur in November.
- New Board Members: Nolene will follow up with some of her contacts about possible new members for the Board of Guardians. Larry and Darlene Clark's term is up in May. They will stay on if new members cannot be found. Lynda will visit with Cody Kilmar in Riggins and see if he or his wife would be interested in serving or if they know of anyone who would be a good member. Debbie will attend a Human Needs Council meeting and ask if anyone from their council would be willing to serve.
