- * Do you want to help plan and create the fun stage in the arena building for the fair?

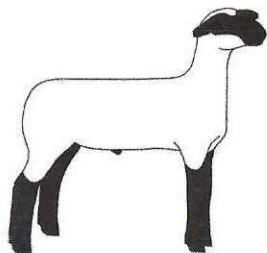
The 2024 Fashion Board will begin meeting soon!
