The Project includes the following Work: Reconstruction of approximately two miles of flood-damaged roadway. The anticipated work includes roadway excavation, multiple slope repairs, multiple MSE wall installations, riprap placement, ditch regrading, gravel roadway surfacing, removal and replacement of multiple culverts, and installation of ditch underdrains.
