Board meeting minutes 8/19/2026

Meeting brought to order @ 1.05 PM

1st Order of business was to elect Board Officers as follows:

Chairman: Dave Galantuomini

Vice Chairman: Todd Stenzel

Secretary/Treasurer: Ed Anglesey

A short discussion ensued regarding distribution of the minutes upon approval. Dave will send copies to interested parties and Ed will forward approved minutes to Kathy Ackerman of Idaho County and Joann Davis of Clearwater County to be posted on the respective county websites.

There was then a short discussion regarding length of terms for officers and it was decided to take no action on this so we can see how the next couple of years plays out regarding more equipment acquisitions and potential division of county jurisdiction of equipment.

Next, a discussion of projects for use of the trail cat. It was decided that each club will discuss what their wish list is of a program of work and these "wish lists" will be presented at a meeting in February so the CITMB can determine priorities and also becoming familiar with the use of the trailcat. Both Clearwater and Idaho Counties will submit wish lists for review.

Our next discussion centered around frequency of meetings. It was moved by Dave and seconded by Ron, voted unanimously to initially hold monthly meetings until the end of the year. The meetings will occur on the third (3rd) Wednesday of the month. They will be held at the USFS Office in Kamiah (1008 Highway 64 Kamiah, ID 83536).

The respective County Clerks will be informed of this schedule through these minutes.

The IDPR has committed the amount of \$5000 through a grant to be deposited into the operating Bank Account administered by Clearwater County. These funds are earmarked as operating funds for the CITMB/TrailCat Program. IDPR also committed to training for potential Trail Cat operators.

The business of assembling the By Laws for the CITMB was discussed and will be addressed at our next meeting.

The final discussion pertained to the cooperative concerns with the USFS when it comes to actually doing the work. Because of past difficulties in dealing with the USFS the subject was brought up. Commissioner Brandt of Idaho County and Commissioner Reggear of Clearwater County assured the Board that any difficulties that might arise could be taken to them and they will be handled. There was reference to Tom Schultz, our current Chief of the Forest Service to address any issues that may arise on the local level. This was reassuring to the Board.

Meeting was adjourned at 2:20 PM on a motion from Ed and second by Todd followed by a unanimous vote.
