Can you renew your U.S. Passport by mail?

You can renew your passport by mail if you answer “yes” to all 5 of the following questions about your passport:

1. You have your passport in your possession to submit with your application.
2. It's undamaged other than normal wear and tear.
3. Was issued when you were 16 or older.
4. It was issued within the last 15 years.
5. Was issued in your current name or you can document your name change.
(original or certified copies)

To renew your passport, you will need:

1. To fill out DS-82 Form
2. Submit your most recent U.S. Passport
3. Include name change documents (if applicable)
4. Provide a new passport photo
5. Include a personal check, cashier's check or money order – **Temporary or bank counter checks are not accepted by the U.S. Department of State.**
